Criminal Complaint

Michael Yogerst, of the Germantown Police Department, being first duly sworn, states that:

Count 1: CRIMINAL DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

The above-named defendant on or about June 19, 2011, in the Village of Germantown, Washington County, Wisconsin, did intentionally cause damage to the physical property of another, belonging to Linda Palmer, without that person's consent, contrary to sec. 943.01(1), 939.51(3)(a) Wis. Stats., a Class A Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

Count 2: CRIMINAL DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

The above-named defendant on or about June 19, 2011, in the Village of Germantown, Washington County, Wisconsin, did intentionally cause damage to the physical property of another, belonging to Kathleen A Sanders, without that person's consent, contrary to sec. 943.01(1), 939.51(3)(a) Wis. Stats., a Class A Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

Count 3: BURGLARY OF A BUILDING OR DWELLING

The above-named defendant on and between June 18, 2011 and June 22, 2011, in the Village of Germantown, Washington County, Wisconsin, did intentionally enter a building, the storage unit of Scott Timple, without the consent of the person in lawful possession of the place, and with intent to steal, contrary to sec. 943.10(1m)(a), 939.50(3)(f) Wis. Stats., a Class F Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), or imprisoned not more than twelve (12) years and six (6) months, or both.

Count 4: BURGLARY OF A BUILDING OR DWELLING

The above-named defendant on and between June 18, 2011 and June 22, 2011, in the Village of Germantown, Washington County, Wisconsin, did intentionally enter a building, the storage unit of Scott Timple, without the consent of the person in lawful possession of the place, and with intent to steal, contrary to sec. 943.10(1m)(a), 939.50(3)(f) Wis. Stats.,

a Class F Felony, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), or imprisoned not more than twelve (12) years and six (6) months, or both.

Count 5: CRIMINAL DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

The above-named defendant on and between June 13, 2011 and June 20, 2011, in the Village of Germantown, Washington County, Wisconsin, did intentionally cause damage to the physical property of another, belonging to Michael C Flesses, without that person's consent, contrary to sec. 943.01(1), 939.51(3)(a) Wis. Stats., a Class A Misdemeanor, and upon conviction may be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), or imprisoned not more than nine (9) months, or both.

PROBABLE CAUSE:

Complainant prays that said defendant be dealt with according to law. The basis for the complainant's charge of such offense is he is a Detective with the Village of Germantown Police Department and bases his information upon review of the written police report of Officer Robert Case of the Germantown Police Department, who reports that on June 19, 2011, at 1:14 p.m., he was contacted by Sheila Witt, an adult citizen whom he believed to be truthful and reliable, who stated she is the owner of the Storaway storage units located at W140 N10065 Fond du Lac Avenue, Village of Germantown, Washington County, Wisconsin, that she reported nine separate units had the locks cut off at the storage unit, namely, Units A24, A46, B27, B31, B35, B38, B47, D24, and E2930, that she is responsible for the missing locks and will have to replace them, and that no one had permission to cut off the locks on the storage units. Witt further stated the nine units are rented by eight separate individuals or businesses.

Officer Case further reports he spoke with Linda Palmer, an adult citizen whom he believed to be truthful and reliable, who stated she is employed by Karthauser & Sons and advised that Unit A46 was rented by Karthauser & Sons to store paperwork, that nothing was missing, and that no one had permission to cut off the lock or enter the unit. Officer Case further reports he spoke with Kathleen Sanders, an adult citizen whom he believed to be truthful and reliable, who stated Unit B47 was rented by her, that nothing was missing, and that no one had permission to cut off the lock or enter the unit. Officer Case further reports he spoke with Rudy Custer, an adult citizen whom he believed to be truthful and reliable, who stated Unit B31 was rented by him, that nothing was missing, and that no one had permission to cut off the lock or enter the unit.

Complainant further bases his information upon review of the written police report of Officer Shawn Officer Marten of the Germantown Police Department, who reports that on June 26, 2011, at 1:36 p.m., he spoke with Scott Timple, an adult citizen whom he believed to be truthful and reliable, who stated that sometime between Saturday, June 18, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. and Wednesday, June 22, 2011 at 2:00 p.m., someone cut off the locks of his two storage units, Units 9K and 9M, at TriStar Storage located at W172 N13010 Division Road, Village of Germantown, Washington County, Wisconsin, and removed numerous items, and that no one had permission to enter his storage units or to take any property from them. Timple further stated that items taken included Franklin Mint 1:24 die

cast cars, a Danbury Mint 1:12 die cast car, poker chips, a cut glass Nascar display, a key holder cabinet, and that the total value of the stolen items from both of his storage units was \$4,442.00.


Complainant further bases his information upon review of the written police report of Officer Brian Ball of the Germantown Police Department, who reports that on June 30, 2011, he was dispatched to TriStar Storage at the aforementioned location, that dispatch had received a phone call from Michael Flesses, an adult citizen whom he believed to be truthful and reliable, who stated that sometime between June 13, 2011 and June 20, 2011, an unknown subject had entered his storage locker without his consent, although he was unable to determine if any property was taken, but his lock was cut off without his consent.


Complainant further bases his information upon review of the written police report of Officer David Pierzchalski of the Germantown Police Department, who reports that on June 23, 2011, at 2:39 p.m., he met with Janet Boehlke, an adult citizen whom he believed to be truthful and reliable, who stated she is the manager at TriStar Storage, that on that day she had made a complete check of the whole facility and located approximately seventeen storage units that had their locks removed, and that this was done without consent.

Complainant further bases his information upon review of the written police report of Detective Penny Schmitt of the Germantown Police Department, who reports that on July 17, 2011, she had the occasion to interview one Brian T. Anderson, the defendant herein, that the defendant made a statement to her she believed to be reliable as a statement against penal interest, wherein the defendant stated he went to the Storaway and TriStar storage areas between June 17, 2011 and June 22, 2011, that he cut off the locks of several storage units with a bolt cutters, that he entered the units and looked for something he could take because he was unemployed, and that it was his intent to find a lot of money so he could "get the hell out of Wisconsin." Detective Schmitt further stated the defendant denied taking \$4,000 worth of items from the Scott Timple storage unit.

Based on the foregoing, the complainant believes this complaint to be true and correct.
