THE BELOW NAMED COMPLAINANT BEING DULY SWORN, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF STATES THAT:

Count 1: POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY A FELON

Case 2022CE000167

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, December 30, 2021, at 2201 West Purdue Street, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did possess a firearm, having been convicted of a felony in this state, contrary to sec. 941.29(1m)(a), 939.50(3)(g) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class G Felony, the defendant may be fined not more than Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), or imprisoned not more than ten (10) years, or both.

Count 2: DISORDERLY CONDUCT, USE OF A DANGEROUS WEAPON

The above-named defendant on or about Thursday, December 30, 2021, at 2201 West Purdue Street, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, while in a public place, did engage in otherwise disorderly conduct, under circumstances in which such conduct tended to cause a disturbance, contrary to sec. 947.01(1), 939.51(3)(b), 939.63(1)(b) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class B Misdemeanor, the defendant may be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or imprisoned not more than ninety (90) days, or both.

And further, invoking the provisions of sec. 939.63(1)(b) Wis. Stats., because the defendant committed this offense while using a dangerous weapon, the maximum term of imprisonment for the felony may be increased by not more than 5 years.

Probable Cause:

I am a Milwaukee County law enforcement officer, and I base this complaint upon reports created in the ordinary course of business of the Milwaukee Police Department, which I have relied upon in the past and found to be truthful, accurate, and regularly relied upon in the course of that department's business. Said reports indicate the following:

On the above date, at the above place, Milwaukee Police Department Officer Benjamin Bender was dispatched to a report of a Shotspotter detecting two rounds of ammunition having been fired. Upon arrival, Officer spoke with ZEH, who said that the above-named defendant, her boyfriend, had shot a firearm. ZEH said that the defendant carries a silver and black Warthawg .45 caliber handgun, and that during this incident, the defendant took out a firearm and fired it twice into the air while in his vehicle. ZEH was described as nervous and fearful as she spoke to officers.

Officers found two spent casing on the ground at the scene.

ZEH said she contacted the defendant during the incident on her phone, and that the defendant bragged about getting a new gun and said "U know I test them after I get m not knowing it was be all this Bs I got it from around the corner."

Your complainant has reviewed the records of the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access online (CCAP), which revealed that the defendant, at the time of this offense, was a person convicted of a felony under Wisconsin Court Case No. 11CF4543 of a violation of Burglary as Party To A Crime, under Wisconsin Stat. § 943.10(1m)(a), and 939.05. That conviction remains of record and unreversed.
