**SEARCH WARRANT**

The State of Wisconsin, to any Law Enforcement Officer of the State of Wisconsin:

*WHEREAS*, Police Officer Peter Hauser has this day complained (by attached affidavit) to this Court upon oath showing probable cause that on Tuesday, March 29th, 2022, in the County of Milwaukee, there is now located and concealed in and upon certain premises, located within the City of Milwaukee, in said County, occupied by *Allen Addison (b/m)*, and more particularly described as follows:

**DESCRIBE PREMISES:** A two story, upper/lower dwelling. This house has a brown over white sided exterior with white framed windows with a brown and white wooden porch. The main entry / exit to the building is located on the east exterior wall of the building with the numbers "2313" and "2315" in black and white letters to the left of the front exit/entry door. The house has a rear entry / exit door on the south side of the structure. The house has a detached gray brick and red shingled roof 2 car garage behind it (west), which has white trim.

**DESCRIBE OBJECTS OF SEARCH:**

1. Black 9mm semi-automatic firearm
2. Shell casings, ammunition or any other related items to firearm or firearm related accessories
3. Personal identifiers of residents of the residence

Which thing(s) (were used in the commission) or (may constitute evidence) of a crime, to-wit:

**DESCRIBE CRIME OR CRIMES:**

- (1) 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Reckless Endangering Safety
- (2) Felon in Possession of a Firearm

Committed in violation of Section(s) 941.30(1); 941.29(1M)(a) of the Wisconsin State Statutes.

*THEREFORE*, in the name of the State of Wisconsin, you are commanded forthwith to search the said premises and/or the said person(s) for said things, and take possession thereof, if found. You are further commanded to return this warrant within forty-eight hours before the Assistant Chief Deputy Clerk of the Circuit Court, Crime, Misdemeanor, Traffic Division, or his designee, to be dealt with according to law.

Possession of a Firearm-Convicted Felon which crimes are contrary to Wisconsin Statutes, sec 941.30(2) and 941.29(1m)(a).

7. Affiant is aware on March 29, 2022 at approximately 3:26pm Milwaukee Police Department Officers responded to 2313 N. 41st St. to locate Allen Addison. Through historical records this address revealed to be the address of Allen Addison's uncle, (b/m ).
8. The affiant is aware upon officers knocking on the residence; Allen Addison was observed inside of the residence and did not immediately come out. Addison was observed moving about the house out of view of the officers while attempting to call him out of the residence.
9. Affiant is aware Addison exited the residence at approximately 5:38pm and taken into custody over two hours after officers began knocking on the residence.
10. Affiant is also aware the owner of the residence 2313 N 41st St (lower) and 2315 N 41st St. (upper) was spoken to by officers, identified as ( ). She indicated to officers lives in the lower unit of 2313 and his sister, (the sister of ) lives in the upper unit with her husband.
11. Affiant believes, while officers were knocking, Addison had access not only to the basement but to the lower unit of 2313 N. 41<sup>st</sup> St. and also to the upper unit of 2315 N. 41<sup>st</sup> St., being his aunt's residence ( ).
12. The affiant is aware that the interior of the residence of 2313 N. 41<sup>st</sup> St and 2315 N. 41<sup>st</sup> St. is a residence in which Addison did occupy and have access to. While police officers and detectives attempted to gain entry to this residence, the occupants are refusing to answer to door. There is a good chance of recovering evidence as it pertains to this offence upon entry to the residence.
13. Affiant is aware prior to, during and after Addison was taken into custody, officers have maintained containment on the residence, not allowing persons or articles to come or go from the aforementioned residence.
14. The affiant is aware that the residence of 2313 and 2315 N. 41<sup>st</sup> St. has been described as a two story, upper/lower dwelling. This house has a brown over white sided exterior with white framed windows with a brown and white wooden porch. The main entry / exit to the building is located on the east exterior wall of the building with the numbers "2313" and "2315" in black and white letters to the left of the front exit/entry door. The house has a rear entry / exit door on the south side of the structure. The house has a detached gray brick and red shingled roof 2 car garage behind it (west), which has white trim.

#### CONCLUSION

15. **LASTLY**, affiant is aware that a search warrant may be issued when the application establishes probable cause to believe that evidence connected with a crime will be found at the place to be searched and that probable cause supporting a search warrant is determined by the "totality of the circumstances" wherein the task of the issuing Judge is to simply make a practical, commonsense decision whether, given all of the circumstances as set forth in the affidavit, that there is a fair probability that contraband or evidence of a crime will be found in a particular place; furthermore, affiant is also aware that the Courts have determined that probable cause is not a technical, legalistic concept, but a flexible commonsense measure of the plausibility of specific conclusions; that elaborate specificity is not required and that probable cause may be supported by inferences as well as facts;
16. **WHEREFORE**, affiant believes, based on the above stated information, that affiant has established the requisite amount of probable cause to believe that evidence of the crime of 1st Degree Reckless Endangering Safety and Possession of a Firearm-Convicted Felon

which crimes are contrary to Wisconsin Statutes, sec 941.30(2) and 941.29(1m)(a), does now exist at the location of 2313 and 2315 N 41<sup>st</sup> St; that based upon affiant's training and experience, affiant seeks permission to search all persons on the premises because the premises in question is a private residence and evidence may easily be secreted inside or on the people inside;
