
Wisconsin CD-3 Poll Findings RE:

Fresh polling data demonstrates that the political environment significantly favors Republicans in this district. Republican Derrick Van Orden holds a substantial advantage in the race to fill Democratic Rep. Ron Kind's open seat in Congress.

Van Orden leads 50-38% over Brad Pfaff

- With a large edge in both name identification and favorability, Derrick Van Orden is able to expand his lead beyond that of the generic ballot advantage for a Republican.
- In this heavily blue-collar district, Van Orden leads by 20% among working-class voters.
- Just 12% of voters are undecided.


Congressional Ballot

Generic Congressional Ballot






Biden job approval deeply underwater

METHODOLOGY: The survey was conducted among 403 likely general election voters in Wisconsin CD-3 on August 15-18, 2022 and has a margin of error of ±4.86%. Known registered voters were interviewed via live phone calls, SMS-to-web and email-to-web. The survey sample was weighted to reflect a representative sample of the likely 2022 general electorate in Wisconsin CD-3.
